An adult oyster can filter about 50 gallons of water a day. So, Domino® Sugar Refinery employees partnered with the Chesapeake Bay Foundation to raise 150,000 baby oysters. While living in a sanctuary reef in the Patapsco River, the oysters will filter water headed for the Chesapeake Bay. Over an expected 20-year lifetime, they will treat about 7.5 million gallons of water.
