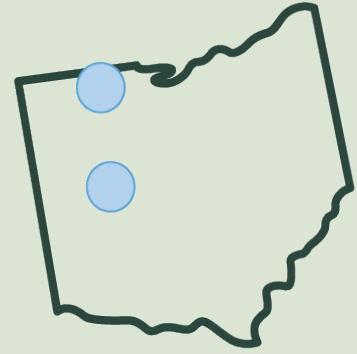


# SUGAR'S IMPACT ON OHIO

### FUN FACT



The first sugarbeet factory in Ohio was built in Fremont in 1900 by the Continental Sugar Company. The last sugarbeets grown in Ohio were harvested over 20 years ago.

Today, the grower-owners of Michigan Sugar Company raise sugarbeets in Michigan, where the sugar is extracted and packaged for delivery to food manufacturers and store shelves. Much of that sugar is sent to Ohio storage facilities in Fremont and Toledo, making the sugarbeet industry critical to Ohio.
