PRIORITIZE PEOPLE

by paving the way for young farmers, investing in local communities, paying workers fair wages and benefits, providing development opportunities for our diverse workforce, prioritizing safety on the farm and in the factory, and creating opportunities to cooperatively own companies.



PROTECT THE PLANET

by reducing greenhouse gases, improving water and soil quality, and sequestering carbon. U.S. farmers produce 16% more sugar on 11% less land than they did 25 years ago.



PRODUCE INNOVATIVE PRODUCTS

by operating under strict safety standards and utilizing all parts of the crop to reduce waste and create beneficial co-products for our customers.



PROMOTE FAIR-PRICE POLICIES

by supporting a sugar policy that provides consumers with affordable sugar, helps farmers mitigate risks and invest in sustainable production, and encourages fair global sugar markets.
